## Woman, 106, Oldest in State, Dies

VERMONTVILLE — Mrs. Hiram Grant, the oldest woman in Michigan and possibly the oldest person in the state, died Friday II night at her home at 345 E Main St. She was 196.

Her title as the state's oldest woman was confirmed last May by Michigan Week officials.

Mrs. Grant, the former Emma Olin, was born Jan. 9, 1860, in Chester Township, five miles TY east of here. She married Hiram Grant on Dec. 3, 1879, in Char-lotte He died in 1940.

During the early years of their married life the couple lived in NIN a farm house on Brown Road pat northeast of here. They bartered eggs and other farm produce for articles they needed. Wild game INST provided meat for the table.

They moved to the Main Streetperat address in 1911 and Grant continued farming until he was in CH his 80s. Mrs. Grant was bedridden
