## Woman, 106, Oldest in State, Dies

VERMONTVILLE — Mrs. Hiram Grant, the oldest woman in Michigan and possibly the oldest person in the state, died Friday night at her home at 345 E. Main St. She was 106.

Her title as the state's oldest woman was confirmed last May by Michigan Week officials.

Mrs. Grant, the former Emma Olin, was born Jan. 9, 1860, in Chester Township, five miles east of here. She married Hiram Grant on Dec. 3, 1879, in Charlotte. He died in 1940.

During the early years of their married life the couple lived in a farm house on Brown Road northeast of here. They bartered eggs and other farm produce for articles they needed. Wild game provided meat for the table.

They moved to the Main Street address in 1911 and Grant continued farming until he was in his 80s.

Mrs. Grant was bedridden
