Pioneer Lansing Merchant To Be Buried Here on Tuesday Afternoon

Funeral services for Frank N. Arbaugh, 82, of 439 S. Verlinden ave., founder and chairman of the board of the F. N. Arbaugh company, will be held at 2:30 p. m. Tuesday at Estes-Leadley funeral home.

Mr. Arbaugh died Saturday night at his home, following an illness of several months.

Rev. William G. Kuhen, minister of the First Presbyterian church, will officiate at the final rites for Mr. Arbaugh, and interment will be in the Evergreen cemetery. Pallbearers will be Clarence R. Knapp, Hubert Bates, Albert Elsesser, B. C. Fowler, Joseph Foster, Andrew DeVries, Simeon R. Dietrich and Richard P. Lyman.
