This Indenture made this nineteenth day of July in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifty one between Rufus Hanes and Sarah M. Hanes his wife of Vermontville Eaton County & State of Michigan of the first part and the Board of Health and their Successors in Office of the aforesaid township of Vermontville of the second part, Witnesseth, that the said parties of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of twenty five dollars lawful money of the United States to them in hand paid by the said party of the second part the receipt whereof is hereby confessed and acknowledged have granted, bargained, sold and released and by their heirs do grant, bargain, sell release and convey unto the said party of the second part and to their Successors in office forever

All that Certain piece or parcel of land known and described as follows to wit: Commencing at a point twenty five Rods East of & ten Rods and Six links North of the South West Corner of the South West one fourth of Section thirteen (13) in town three (3) North and Range Six (6) West in Eaton County and State of Michigan (Magnetic Variation one point less than four Degrees) Running thence North ten Rods, thence East eight Rods, thence South ten Rods, thence West to the place of Beginning containing one half acre of land for the purpose of a burying ground. Also a divisible Right of way for passing & Carriages from South West Corner of said Burying ground running South to the highway of two Rods wide a Gate to be built and supported on said highway by the aforesaid Township of Vermontville

Together with all and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances therunto belonging or in any wise appertaining unto all the Estate, Right, title, Interest, Claim and demand of the said parties of the first part either in Law or Equity of or unto the above described premises with the said hereditaments and appurtenances. To have and to hold the Above described unto the said parties of the second part and to their Successors in office forever. And the said parties of the first part for themselves and their heirs, Executors, administrators or assigns do hereby Covenant and agree with the said parties of the second part and their Successors in Office, that at the time of the delivery hereof they were the lawful owners of the premises and Seized of a good and indefeasible Estate of an Inheritance therein in fee Simple, Clear of all encumbrance whatever and that the above bargained premises in the quiet and peaceful possession of the said parties of the second part and their Successors in Office the said parties of the first part will forever Warrant and defend
