Rules for Burials

- No burials will be made during the winter months. Cutoff date will be made by Sexton with help from President and Secretary
- There will be an additional charge for Sunday burials.
- All grave openings and funerals will be conducted in a timely manner only after notice by funeral home or family.
- All burials will be made by Michigan burial permits or cremation certificate and all will be recorded by the secretary.
- Graves shall be laid out by Sexton or person designated by President or Secretary of cemetery board.

Cemetery Rules and Regulations

- Name- Vermontville Cemetery Association
- Purpose- To make available burial spaces and services for sale for separation of cemetery.
- No sale, transfer or assignment of the certificate of ownership of any lot shall be valid without the consent of the President or Secretary and their approval endorsed on the deed.
- The cemetery board without desiring to interfere with the good taste of lot owner, yet in justice to the interest of the cemetery, reserves the right given them by law of preventing or removing any object or structure which they shall consider injurious to the good appearance of the grounds and particularly to adjoining lots.
- The grade of all lots and alleys will be required to conform to the general outline of the plats in which they are situated.
- The cemetery board will plant trees and shrubs in accordance with a general plan for ornamenting and embellishing the cemetery. Additional planting by lot
