owners will be permitted by the cemetery board that first shall approve of the trees and shrubs to be planted and designate the location of the same.

2011

- If any tree or shrub standing on any lot or alley shall by its roots. Branches or otherwise become detrimental, dangerous or inconvenient to adjacent lots or alleys, the cemetery board shall have the right, and it shall be their duty, to remove such tree or shrub or such part thereof as they may deem detrimental, dangerous or inconvenient.
- The owner of any lot shall be permitted to erect monuments or head stones, the foundations to be of solid concrete. Foundations to be put in by Sexton or other person designated by cemetery board.
- All graves shall be dug by such person or persons as the President or Secretary of the board shall approve.
- Whenever interment is to be made, timely notice must be given to President or Secretary or person opening grave.
- To enable cemetery board to keep a proper record of each burial, funeral directors of family members shall furnish a burial permit or cremation certificate at time of burial.
- All vehicles are absolutely prohibited from driving over platted ground of the cemetery unless permission is granted by Sexton or cemetery board.
- The Cemetery board reserves the right to refuse any company or person from working anywhere in or on cemetery grounds, and lots or alleys.
- There shall be no spreading of cremated ashes above ground anywhere in the cemetery.
- Cemetery board will set and furnish lists of all fees and charges for lots and services.
- The Vermontville Township Board will review all rules and decisions by cemetery board and maintain the right to uphold or over rule cemetery board.
